

Covid-19 (Coronavirus) – Public Announcement

Amid the Coronavirus public health issue, the health and safety of all customers and staff of The Boathouse is of paramount importance to us. We want to reassure you that we are doing all we can to minimise the risk of spread. We continually monitor Government guidelines and follow all advice, which is currently for the UK population to go about their business as usual until further notice, but to take the following precautions:

- Wash your hands often with warm soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser. This is particularly important after taking public transport.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the bin.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Self-Isolate for 7 days if you are showing even minor symptoms.

We are also taking the following actions to ensure that we minimise spread of the virus:

- Our restaurant undergoes a daily deep clean, ensuring all exposed metal and plastic surfaces are disinfected at the end of each day.
- Throughout the day we diligently, clean and disinfect all high traffic areas.
- All customers are kindly asked to keep used tissues and dispose of, in bins, off-site. We request that used tissues are not left on tables or passed back into the kitchen with food waste.
- We also encourage our customers to wash hands with soap and water on arrival or use a hand sanitiser.

We continue to monitor the situation and follow government advice. We will respond to any developing restrictions as they arise and update this page accordingly. Finally, in line with a request from Public Health England, we will be displaying information within our establishment.
